



## First Home Closes at Cadence Point

Less than a year after construction began, the Cadence Point Development in Brevard North Carolina delivered its first home on Friday, April 30<sup>th</sup>.

The Maple, a Craftsman-style home with a charming red shingled façade was the first home closed on at the development. The owners are leaving Florida behind and relocating to the Blue Hills of Brevard North Carolina. Their new home offers an open floor plan, large master bedroom and a stunning great room with its own fireplace.

The Maple is one of the first two houses to be built at Cadence Point. In addition to the Maple, the Grove was also completed in April. This Charleston-inspired cornflower blue home boasts a gourmet kitchen, master bedroom suite with walk-in closet and a second floor study featuring a dramatic balcony overlook. It also has a detached, two-car carriage house. Open houses are being held every weekend for the Grove.

These two homes are just the first of the 31 that will eventually become part of the Cadence Point Community. A charming pavilion, and sprawling victory garden are in the works as well and a relaxing comprehensive bike path already wends its way along the development.
